e-Granthalaya is a Library Management Software which is very useful for computerization of library activities and user services. During the year 2011, we have improved various forms of the software, added reports, modified many forms, and removed various bugs reported by the users. Besides, Web OPAC of the software re-designed and submitted for the Web Audit and passed/hosted for many libraries.

e-Granthalaya Ver.3.0 is a multi-lingual, UNICODE compliant database and provides data entry solution for local/stand-alone/LAN based as well as WAN based database connectivity. It consists of the following components:

1. Back-end Database in MS SQL Server 2005
2. Web OPAC – Web based Search interface (ASP.NET 2.0)
3. Reports – Crystal Reports
4. Data Entry Programs for Clients (VB.NET)
5. GranthService (A WCF Web Service in .NET 3.0) Layer for Remote Connectivity




Fig.1: e-Granthalaya Home Page

3. Union Catalog of Libraries powered by e-Granthalaya

A New kind of service was launched from NIC for the benefits of Indian libraries in general and users of e-Granthalaya specifically. Under the services, a Union Catalog of libraries which are using e-Granthalaya software has been hosted in NIC Server and available in public domain at <http://www.eglibnet.gov.in>. Besides, a home page is provided to each member library to host/search its own catalog with an individual web URL. Later, some APIs will be added in the site to integrate this service with the libraries parent organization web site. At present, over 5.6 lakhs catalog records are uploaded in the database and available for access.




Fig.2: Union Catalog of Indian libraries home page







RS 117 LAKH PILOT PROJECT FOR LIBRARIES LAUNCHED GOVT TO AUTOMATE 3 PUBLIC LIBRARIES IN SRINAGAR

Srinagar, Oct 28: With the handing over of Rs 116.72 lakh pilot phase of the automation and networking of public libraries project, J&K on Friday took a major leap towards providing modern library services to book lovers. Initially, State's four major public libraries including SRS Central Library, Jammu, SPS Central Library, Srinagar, Oriental Research Library, Hazratbal and City Central Library, Karan Nagar are being automated and networked while the rest would be taken up in the second phase.

The project was launched by Minister for Tourism and Culture, Nawang Riezin Jora. Describing the project as an important milestone in upgrading library services, Jora said it would bring J&K at par with national and international standards. He said Jammu & Kashmir has a 132 year history of public library services as the first library in the State, the SPSI library, was established at Jammu in 1879 followed by setting up of SPS Library at Srinagar in 1898. He said with such a long history it was very essential to switch over to the automated library management to meet the present day requirement.

The Minister described the launch of the project as a significant step towards revolutionizing library services in the State and complimented Director Libraries for taking this initiative as well as many others to upgrade library facilities in the State.



services. Like other sectors had suffered setback but have now been put on the rails again with several initiatives taken by the department for the improvement of infrastructure and collection. He said that the project has multiple benefits, both for the service provider and the service recipient, including computerized classification, cataloguing, accession, storage, retrieval and circulation of books, online information on library collection, increase in operational efficiency, substantial improvement in quality, speed and effectiveness of the services, access to remote users, user participation in resource sharing library networks, rapid communication with other libraries (including outreach libraries), greater transparency in the purchase of titles for public libraries, and removal of chances of duplication in

completion of the Pilot Phase other public libraries in the State would also be taken up for automation and networking.

Appreciating the automation and networking of public libraries, Minister of State for Tourism and Culture underscored the need for creating awareness about libraries to attract more people to the written word. He enumerated various steps taken by the Government to improve library services and specifically referred to the ongoing construction of the new building for the Central Library at Srinagar and the automation and networking of libraries project.

In his welcome address, Khalid Bashir Ahmad said that his department has taken in hand another major project for digitization and archival of old and rare books with internet access. He said 472 such titles in

and the project proposal submitted by National Informatics Centre is in the final stages of receiving the administrative approval. He said archival of about 6000 digitized manuscripts in different languages, forming a rich and proud collection of the department, is also part of the project, besides designing a website of the department.

Giving a brief account of the recent initiatives taken by his department, Director Libraries & Research said that efforts were on to upgrade library facilities in the State both in terms of infrastructure and collection. He said work is apace on the multi-storied new central library flag-ship project of the department. Estimated to cost Rs. 17.34 crore, the library would provide state-of-the-art library facility in the State with facilities like an art gallery,

scripts, internet café, exhibition hall, children section, researchers' cabins and cafeteria. A new three-storied block was added to the SRS Central Library, Jammu recently. He said new spacious buildings for District Library Pulwama and Gani Memorial Library cum Reading Centre were constructed and thrown open for public in December and June last.

Referring to the selection and purchase of books for libraries, Khalid said that the procedure has been made more transparent and the two committees constituted by the Government every year have been broad-based to include more scholars, writers and intellectuals as members. He said during the current year so far, 1300 latest titles on different subjects were purchased for the libraries. This, he said, is the largest purchase in a given year so far, adding, the process for more purchases this year has been set in motion. He said one of the thrust areas during the current year was to make available books on competitive examinations for the benefit of the aspiring civil servants.

Over 100 titles on different subjects were purchased and made available at central, district and 7 sub-libraries. In the next phase later this year, all block libraries will be also provided these titles, he added.

Terming the publication of Khawar Khus Saligean and Catalogue of Manuscripts as a very significant work, Khalid said with this the publication programme of the department which had suffered a break for

over a three year period has been re-started.

During the workshop, a group of officials of the Department of Libraries and Research and the manpower hired by the project executing agency would be trained in the use of e-Granthalaya software before actually starting data entry as part of the project implementation which will begin immediately after the

conclusion of the workshop.

Speaking on the occasion, Khalid Bashir Ahmad said that the launching of the automation and networking of public libraries is a significant initiative taken by the Government to switch over from manual to automated library service and making library information available online. He said in the first instance four major public libraries including SRS Central Library, SPS central Library, Oriental Research Library and City Central Library have been taken up for automation and networking. On successful completion of the pilot phase, other libraries at district and tehsil level and down would be automated and made part of a single networking system. He said the Department is working on another important project to digitize its rich collection of rare books in various languages and make them available on Internet along with a huge treasure of about 6000 digitized manuscripts. The two projects in conjuncture would revolutionize public library services in the State, he added. Khalid also gave a

brief account of other recent initiatives taken by the Department to improve library services both in terms of infrastructure and collection. He said in the next few years the library services in the State would be reckoned with international standards. He made special mention of books of competitive examination made available this year for student community interested in cracking civil service examinations. He said a many as 100 titles on different subjects prescribed for these examinations have been supplied to central, district and tehsil libraries. Before the closure of the current financial year, libraries at block and border block levels will also be provided these books, he said. 

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
