Latest version of e-Granthalaya i.e. Ver.4.0 is a 'Cloud Ready Application' and provides a Web-based data entry solution in enterprise mode with a centralized database for cluster of libraries. It is made available in NIC National Cloud (Meghraj) for Government Libraries as per the NIC Distribution Policy.
