

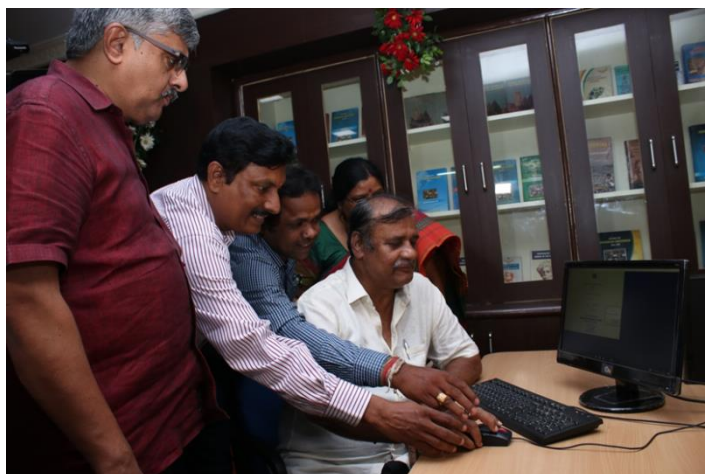
Inauguration of e-Library at Odisha State Archives

The State Archives, Bhubaneswar, Odisha launched e-library system of NIC on 9th June 2017 on the occasion of the International Archives Day.
