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Teacher's Day | CM Yogi will honor teachers on Teachers' Day, five portals will be launched IV News

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Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Monday, on the occasion of Teacher's Day, honored eight principals of the meritorious (Principals) of various boards in Lok Bhavan, besides 75 teachers of the Basic Education Department. State teachers will be honored with the award. CM Yogi will launch five portals of the Secondary Education Department. During this, the Chief Minister will also transfer stipend and escort allowance to girls of Kasturba Gandhi Vidyalaya and children with disabilities under Samarth program through DBT. On the other hand, MoU will also be signed between the Department of Secondary

Education and Uttar Pradesh Skill Development Mission for vocational training and job ready skills to government students under Praveen Yojana in the presence of CM.

Foundation stone will be laid for 14 Inter Colleges

On the occasion of Teacher's Day, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath will felicitate eight principals of meritorious students of UP, CBSE, CISCE, Uttar Pradesh Sanskrit Shiksha Parishad at Lok Bhavan. With this, five portals will be launched namely Access, Pankh, Pragyan, Parakh and Pehchan. At the same time, the foundation stone of 39 new high schools and 14 inter colleges will be laid.

Will launch these portals

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the access: Access portal has been developed for mapping of schools in the state. With this, the information of which schools are located in the state, how many schools are near the city and which place would be suitable for building a new school etc. is in the portal. This will make the system of establishment of secondary schools more transparent.

wing: This portal has been developed for career guidance of students. Through this, after passing the class-10 and class-12 examinations, the information about which option the student should choose to improve his future will be available on the portal. Students will be able to get better advice about available options regarding colleges, scholarships, skill development programmes, internships and education.

Pragyan: E-Library Portal and App Pragyan have been created with the objective of providing reading material to the students. The e-library portal 'Pragyan' and mobile app have been developed to make available contemporary and reference material easily to the students and the general public. The portal houses a vast collection of e-books as well as information on competitive exams, entrepreneurship and startups, NIC e-Granthalaya and UP Library Network.

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Test: In which government school, what resources are there and for the information, supervision and monitoring of the activities happening in the schools, 'Parakh' portal has been developed. Through the portal, online monitoring of the progress of teaching work, attendance of teachers and

non-teaching staff and availability of physical resources will be possible in 2,357 government schools operating in the state as per the prescribed syllabus. The performance standards of schools have also been developed, on the basis of which the category of each government school will be determined. The system of performance based grading will lead to healthy academic competition in schools.

identity: A webpage of every school has been created for the information of 20,941 self-funded recognized, 4,512 aided and 2,357 government schools by the UP Board, which is available on the website of Uttar Pradesh Board of Secondary Education. This webpage contains information about student registration, staff details, facilities, performance in various fields, examination results and outstanding achievements in the school for the public and parents.

MoU will be signed for vocational training and job ready skills

In the program, MoU will be signed between the Department of Secondary Education and Uttar Pradesh Skill Development Mission for vocational training and job ready skills to government students under Praveen Yojana before the Chief Minister. This MoU will be between Dr. Sarita Tiwari, Director of Secondary Education and Andra Vamsi, Mission Director, Skill Development Mission. Under the scheme, in collaboration with the Department of Secondary Education and Uttar Pradesh Skill Development Mission, a free certification course will be conducted on every working day for the development of job-ready skills through vocational training among the students studying in government schools. Along with this, the Chief Minister also laid the foundation stone of 39 new high schools and 14 new inter colleges to provide quality education in the state. With the establishment of these government high schools, about 6,240 students will get the facility of study every year and with the establishment of government inter colleges, about 2,240 students.
